Do you have an up-to-date permit to transport waste in all countries you plan to operate (scope of codes, territory, validity)? ☐ Does your CMR liability insurance (OCP) include environmental liability / waste transport coverage? ☐ Is the vehicle roadworthy and compliant for waste transport (payload, body condition, leak-tightness)? Do you have an emergency response procedure (spill, fire)? ■ Do drivers know basic inspection procedures and whom to contact in emergencies? What to verify during transport: ☐ At loading, was the **second CMR** given (steer clear from document neutralisation; it's illegal in waste transport)? ☐ Are CMR and Annex VII consistent (waste code, weight, description)? Is your waste transport permit valid and covering the specific waste type? Does the driver carry required documents (permit, licence, insurance)? Is SENT (or foreign equivalent) correctly started and active throughout the trip? Has the driver been instructed not to sign anything hastily during control? ☐ Does the driver know how to send photos/scans to the advisor during inspection (WhatsApp, e-mail, panel)? Are inspection protocols and officers' notes archived (copies, photos) and linked to the job? Do you have a plan to minimise downtime costs if the vehicle is held for inspection?
